



NEW BANQUETING SPACE WITH DINING FOR UP TO 500 GUESTS OPENS AT THE LANDMARK LONDON IN SUMMER 2008

In July 2008, the magnificent five-star deluxe Landmark London will dramatically increase the capacity of its banqueting facilities by redeveloping two former banqueting rooms into one space. The newly created Harewood and Music Room will provide an extensive rectangular area catering for a maximum of 1000 guests for a cocktail reception and up to 500 guests for a dinner.

The Landmark London has established a reputation for offering outstanding conference facilities for the most discerning of clients. In the redesigned Harewood and Music Room, the hotel will retain its elegant Victorian style, including an ornate sculptured ceiling, original chandeliers and floor-to-ceiling windows, ensuring it is flooded with natural light.

For guests who wish to divide this large space, an acoustic, sound-proof wall will be drawn across the centre of the room. This dividing wall will be used to create two smaller banqueting rooms and has a door which allows the rooms to be interconnecting if desired. In this format, The Harewood Room will cater for a reception for maximum of 350 guests, and up to 350 in The Music Room.

When The Harewood and Music Room is fully open for a dinner, The Landmark London's elegant Ballroom, with its classical columns and chandeliers, will be used to host a grand pre-dinner Champagne reception.

The hotel's 11 banqueting rooms are individually designed, offering variety in both size and architecture. Most feature natural daylight and high ceilings, while many original features of the building have been retained to enhance the ambience.

The Landmark London, which is renowned as one of the finest Grande Dames amongst London's foremost hotels, is a favourite with A-list celebrities. Built as the last of the great railway hotels during the golden age of steam, it boasts a fascinating history dating from 1899. On entering the gothic, Grade II listed building, The Landmark's soaring eight-storey, glass-roofed central atrium forms a stunning focal point within the hotel.
