



THE LANDMARK LONDON: ICONIC LUXURY IN THE HEART OF MARYLEBONE

An icon of quintessential and elegant London charm, **The Landmark London** is a magnificent five-star Grande Dame hotel located in the heart of Marylebone. One of the oldest railway hotels in London, the stunning hotel was born in the romantic era of train travel, combining opulence, grandeur and timeless service with contemporary flair and five-star amenities, which is best represented through its iconic eight-story high glass atrium, an impressive staple of the hotel since its opening in 1899.

LOCATION

Ideally situated in the heart of Marylebone, The Landmark London offers guests unparalleled access to a wealth of shops, restaurants, and iconic London landmarks. A crowning gem of this vibrant and fashionable neighbourhood, it is conveniently located near attractions for all ages to explore including The Sherlock Holmes Museum, Madame Tussauds and Regent's Park.

ROOMS AND SUITES

Boasting 300 elegant guest rooms, including 62 generously sized suites, the hotel is home to some of the largest and most opulent rooms in London.

Room options range from Superior and Deluxe to Executive and are all designed with a sophisticated neutral colour palette, classic-style beds and stylish Italian marble bathrooms.

For the suite-life, guests can choose from an impressive range of beautifully appointed suites, each with its own style and design. into seven categories: from the Marylebone Studio, Marylebone Family Studio, Marylebone Suite, Atrium Suite, Landmark Suite, Landmark Signature Suite, Great Central Suite, and the Presidential Suite. Some suites offer views of the stunning courtyard, which can be requested at the time of booking. There is a room for every occasion: family rooms, couple stays, romantic breaks and more.

In a move to expand its renowned suite collection, The Landmark London has unveiled two redesigned Signature Suites (110 sqm each), which can be connected to form a luxurious three-bedroom family suite spanning 210 sqm. These suites have been thoughtfully designed to combine light, layered aesthetics with the building's historic charm, blending timeless British heritage with contemporary Asian influences throughout.

The Presidential Suite promises the pinnacle of luxury on a palatial scale. The expansive space and amenities make it one of London's most coveted accommodations complete with a separate lounge, dining room, a fully equipped kitchenette and dressing room.

ELEGANT DRINKING & DINING

The Landmark London features four drinking and dining destinations, each with its own unique character and impressive offering.

The Winter Garden Restaurant

Set under the hotel's grand eight-storey stunning glass atrium and iconic palm trees is the Winter Garden Restaurant.

With new Head Chef, Brian Hennessey, at the helm, the palm tree filled restaurant focuses on a seasonal, modern European menu. Inspired by Brian's travels across the globe, expect a menu of expertly crafted dishes which marry classical flavours with modern techniques. Showcasing his creative flair, starters spotlight seasonal ingredients at their finest, from *Seared venison*

carpaccio with a Comté cheese and pecan praline; and *Citrus cured Scottish salmon* with Platinum caviar and a miso-buttermilk dressing; to *Salt-baked beetroot* within a lime beetroot gazpacho, topped with walnuts.

Blending European classics with quality, British ingredients, mains include a *Glazed Merry-field duck breast* with cherries, blackberries and caramelised walnuts, and *Wild seabass* with brown shrimps, mussels and a lobster sauce. Served tableside, the star of the show is the hand-crafted *Beef Wellington for two*, available Friday-Sunday, and served medium-rare with buttered mash and a rich red wine gravy.

During the day, the restaurant also plays hosts to the Landmark's Afternoon Tea offering, carefully crafted by Executive Pastry Chef, Matteo Sargentelli, with seasonal variations and events taking place throughout the year

Great Central Pub by Matt Fletcher

A British gastropub from the core, Great Central Pub is a more relaxed concept for The Landmark London. Run by Chef de Cuisine Matt Fletcher, the pub marries the old with the new, honouring the original design, with interiors paying homage to the romantic era of travel.

Fletcher's menus offer comforting pub classics with modern twists including *Beer Battered British Market Fish with Hand Cut Chips* and the *Chargrilled Angus Beef Burger*, whilst at the bar, discover a selection of locally sourced beers and a refined wine list.

Mirror Bar

Mirror Bar invites guests to revel in the glamorous ambience of a hidden London hideaway. The beautiful and sophisticated space offers an innovative menu of expertly crafted cocktails, fine wines, spirits and beers, alongside elevated bar snacks and light bites.

Expert mixologists are on-hand to guide guests through the creative and bespoke menu of cocktails, including The Landmark London's signature cocktail *The Cuvee Old Fashioned*, which is a combination of brown butter infused Wild Turkey 101, with a subtle pairing of coffee liqueur, tonka bean and Xocoatl bitters.

The Mirror Bar's enchanting terrace is the perfect destination for pre-dinner cocktails or late-night drinks alongside a selection of cigars.

The Champagne Bar

Tucked away under a botanic horizon is the stunning Champagne Bar, offering a wide range of luxury Champagnes. These include a range of vintages such as Taittinger Brut 2015 or Veuve Clicquot Grand Dame 2012, as well as a choice of two magnums.

Alongside the extensive drinks menu is a sophisticated food menu. Highlight small plates include *Brixham white crab with avocado and tomato on top of a toasted crumpet and drizzled with brown crab butter*, *Smoked Scottish Salmon* and *Platinum Caviar*.

Located above the Winter Garden in the atrium, the Champagne Bar is a striking golden raised bar or plush sofas and armchairs spanning the vast terrace. Whilst leafing through the menus, drinkers and diners will enjoy live piano music from the Winter Garden Restaurant below. A romantic setting, guests can relax under dazzling sunlight during the day, or the night sky visible through the glass atrium ceiling.

THE LANDMARK SPA & WELLNESS – SPA AT THE LANDMARK LONDON

Recently refurbished following a £multi-million transformation, The Spa at The Landmark London offers a 710-square-metre urban sanctuary.
